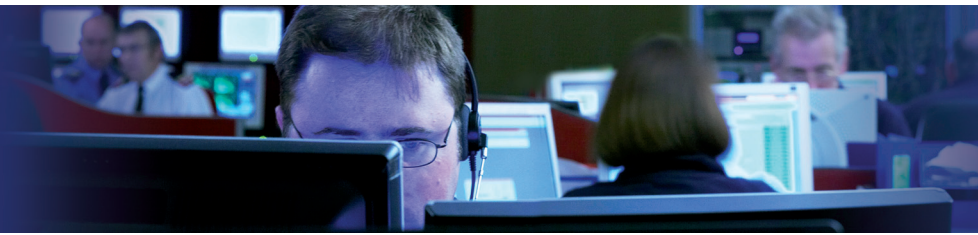

Lone Workers

Lone or vulnerable workers are people who work on their own or work with others but in vulnerable and/or potentially threatening situations, for example this could include bailiffs, enforcement officers, hotel reception staff, `home visit` nursing staff, security staff and council employees.

Under the Health and Safety Act 1974, Employers have a `duty of care` to provide a safe working environment for their employees.

At Securi-Guard Monitoring we monitor a selection of devices for lone or vulnerable workers. All devices work on a principle solution that a worker can be located either by Global Positioning Satellites (GPS) and then tracked or via GSM networks. Communication with the worker can take place through GSM/SMS if within GSM network coverage.

There are many types of devices and solutions available but the introduction of BS 8484 - the Lone Worker standard emphasises the need to be aware of the functionality and capabilities of devices before they are deployed for use. We are fully accredited to NSI Gold BS 8484.

Lone worker monitoring will depend upon your requirements, but must remain within the boundary of BS 8484, give us a call and see what we can offer, we aim to meet your needs.

Depending on the device, Securi-Guard Monitoring are able to track the lone workers location via GPS once the device has been activated, the position is displayed on mapping software and may also allows us to track the worker should they move location. At the same time, a two-way communication channel is opened allowing our Operators to hear and talk to the lone worker (and vice versa) through the device.

Securi-Guard is then able to work with the emergency services supplying the grid, map or latitude/longitude reference of the lone workers location to assist in a quick response/rescue.

All lone worker devices monitored by Securi-Guard use existing mobile network infrastructures, are easy to operate and can be used as two way communication devices, allowing the lone worker to use the device to make and receive calls. Some may also receive text messages.
